Note: All Hotel costs must be covered by all nominated lifters and officials if we have not received information about a cancellation at the latest 7 days prior to the date of the Championship. The deadline is 2nd June 2009. The same applies to the participation and antidoping fees (EPF By-Laws 103.2 and 105.5.1).

The organizer will not be responsible for any hotel bills of the participating nations. All delegates must pay directly their rooms at the arrival at the hotel reception. Payable by credit card or cash (Euro). All the rooms must be booked at latest with the deadline of the final nomination - 19th May 2009.

Payment must be received at the above mentioned bank account at the latest 7 days prior to the beginning of the Championship.

- Arrivals/Transportation: Transport from Jönköping airport to hotels in Jönköping. Price of 20 EUR for round trip must be paid at arrival at the Championships Office. Any national team will not be accredited until the reserved transportation has been paid. Please send therefore your detailed travel itinerary to the Meet Director so that the transfer can be provided.
- Scales: Scales available at venue and at Hotels.
- Training: Training facilities available at venue.
- Flag and anthem: Each country must bring its flags and anthems to the Technical Meeting.

Photos: Identification is necessary for security reasons; each nation must send one photo for each lifter, coach and official. A maximum of three coaches per national team will be allowed into the venue free of charge. Photos must be sent together with the final nominations. If possible, send a digital version by email.

Closing Banquet: Saturday 13th of June at 2000 hours at Pallas Atena Restaurant (400 meters from Comfort Hotel and 100 meters from Hotel Savoy). Price Euro 20,00 per person. Tickets for the Banquet must be payed at the Competition Venue (Information desk) before Friday 12th of June 18.00 hours.

- Participation Fee: 20 EUR for each lifter must be paid by bank transfer to the EPF bank account before the Technical Meeting. EPF invoice will be sent by the EPF Treasurer 7 days before the Technical Meeting.
- Anti-Doping Fee: 50 EUR for each lifter must be paid by bank transfer to the EPF bank account before the Technical Meeting. EPF invoice will be sent by the EPF Treasurer 7 days before the Technical Meeting.
- Opening Ceremony: Wednesday 10th of June at time for Victory ceremony men 52-75 kg, around 1900 hours, at Competition Venue (Idrottshuset). Two representatives (one lifter and one official) from each participating country shall take part at the Ceremony.

Nominations:Team nomination forms must be in the hands of the Meet Director
and the EPF Championship Secretary not later than:Preliminary:10th April 2009 (complete filled in preliminary form must be
sent. No final nomination will be accepted if a complete filled
in preliminary nomination form was not sent in time).

Final: 19th May 2009 (later entries will not be accepted).

Preliminary nominations must be sent not later than 60 days before the date of the Championships. Final nomination must be submitted not later than 21 days before the date of the Championships, and must be made from those nominated 60 days before the date of the Championship. This is inclusive of reserve or alternate lifters. According to this, <u>no reserve lifters can be in the final nomination of any nation.</u>

All lifters are expected to present passports and other required documents at the weigh-in.
