Championship. The deadline is 27<sup>th</sup> of April 2009. The same applies to the participation and anti-doping fees (EPF By-Laws 103.2 and 105.5.1).

The organizer will not be responsible for any hotel bills of the participating nations. All delegates must pay directly their rooms at the arrival at the hotel reception. Arrivals/Transportation: Transport from Rovaniemi airport and Kemi-Tornio airport to hotels

in Ylitornio. Price of 40 EUR for round trip must be paid at arrival at the Championships Office. Any national team will not be accredited

until the reserved transportation has been paid.

account at the latest 7 days before the Technical Meeting. Invoice will

be sent by the EPF Treasurer.

**Opening Ceremony:** Tuesday, 5 May 2009, 1700 hours at Ylitornio Municipal Hall.

Two representatives (one lifter and one official) from each

participating country shall take part at the Ceremony.

**Nominations:** Team nomination forms must be in the hands of the Meet Director and

the EPF Championship Secretary not later than:

**Preliminary:** 5<sup>th</sup> March 2009 (preliminary form must be sent. No final nomination

will be accepted if the preliminary was not sent).

**Final:** 13<sup>th</sup> April 2009 (later entries will not be accepted).

Preliminary nominations must be sent not later than 60 days before the date of the Championships. Final nomination must be submitted not later than 21 days before the date of the Championships, and must be made from those nominated 60 days before the date of the Championship. This is inclusive of reserve or alternate lifters. According to this, no reserve lifters can be in the final nomination of any nation.

All lifters are expected to present passports and other required documents at the weigh-in.
